PARK DESCRIPTION

Chickasaw State Park was named for the Chickasaw Tribe who once inhabited West Tennessee and North Mississippi. The 1,400 acres of land located in West Tennessee was one of Tennessee's 20 New Deal-era state parks. Situated on some of the highest terrain in west Tennessee and surrounded by 14,384 acres of timberland. The park, including its 2 lakes within it, offers many outdoor recreational activities for visitors to embark on.

HOSTING DESCRIPTION

Campground Description

RV Campground

The RV Campground is located on the north west side of Chickasaw State Park, approximately 0.1 miles off of Hwy 100 W in Henderson, TN. The RV campground is one of three in the park (RV/ Tent/ Wrangler). It is wooded with lots of shade options and contains a mixture of back-in and pull-through sites. The RV campground has 53 sites, some accommodating rigs up to 94 feet. Sites have water, 20, 30, 50 amp electrical hookups, and 26 sites offer full hookups with sewer. Each site has a picnic table and grill. A bathhouse provides showers and restroom facilities. A dump station is conveniently located.

Host Site Description

Schedule: March - December

The Camp Host Site is located in RV campsite #1, which is positioned in the center of the campground entrance, is mostly shaded, and is close to a bath house and playground.

The Camp Host Site is equipped with 50, 30, and 20 amp electrical hookups. It is a level, paved, back-in site that includes water and sewer hookups. Parking length is 72 feet, living length is 40 feet, parking width is 14 feet, living width is 16 feet. Wifi is available.

Responsibilities

- Checking in and taking payment from non reserved campers with an online reservation system
- Putting up new and taking down expired site tag markers
- Minor weed eating
- Keeping campsites blown off and clear of litter and debris
- Cleaning out fire rings and campsite grills
- Answering visitor questions
