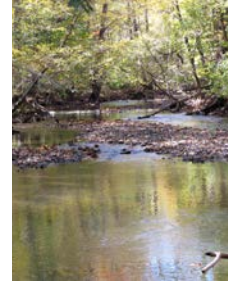




# COVE LAKE STATE PARK

## CAMPGROUND HOST INFORMATION



### PARK DESCRIPTION

Cove Lake's 606 acres are situated in a beautiful mountain valley on the eastern edge of the Cumberland Plateau. Scenic nature trails lead through a diversity of wetlands and woodlands offering wildlife viewing for the nature enthusiast. A paved walking/bike trail provides easy access to all park facilities. Visitors can spend the day fishing or simply sitting back and capturing the picturesque vista Cove Lake offers.

### HOSTING DESCRIPTION

#### Campground Description

Campground is located a short half mile from the Park Entrance and Visitor's Center. It has 100 campsites along 3 connected loops: A- front loop, B- inner loop, C- back loop. All sites are equipped with water and electrical hookups, and most with grills and tables. Tents are allowed on all campsites. A dump station is available, as are two modern bathhouses with hot showers and restrooms. A camp store is open seasonally. Firewood is sold on-site.

#### Host Site Description

*Schedule: April - October*

The host site is #96, located in Loop C of the campground. This site is open with trees along the back of the site. It is a back-in site with 30 amp electrical, water hook-up (no sewer). Nearby bathhouse is located directly across from the camp site, a 50 yard walk with paved sidewalk access.

#### Responsibilities

1. Welcome Campers
2. Check-in campers, make new reservations, and obtain discount verification
3. Put out daily hang tags for incoming campers & pull departed tags
5. Stock bathhouse paper products 1-2 times daily depending on occupancy, and perform occasional cleaning
6. Clean out fire rings and grills (trash, old charcoal and ashes)
7. Pick up litter inside of campground and around the camper check-in office/boat dock area
