PARK DESCRIPTION

Edgar Evins State Park is located on the shores of Center Hill Lake in the steep, hilly Eastern Highland Rim. The 6,000-acre park provides many recreational opportunities, cabins, and campsites on one of the most beautiful reservoirs in Tennessee. The park also has a large on-site marina with a restaurant and gift shop. Wildlife is abundant throughout the park's mixed hardwood forests. An observation tower at the Visitor Center offers a spectacular view of Center Hill Lake and the surrounding hillsides.

HOSTING DESCRIPTION

Campground Description

- The campground is located on a wooded hillside overlooking the marina and Center Hill Lake.
- The campground consists of 60 tent and trailer campsites with electrical and water hookups. These wooden platform-type sites, which are reinforced with concrete and steel, are built around the slopes of Center Hill Lake and are equipped with a picnic table, grill and fire ring. They are designed for trailers or motor homes up to 33 feet in length, with a few select sites up to 40 feet in length. These sites can also accommodate small and large tents.

Host Site Description

Schedule: Year-Round

The host sites are campsites 31 and 32 located close to the middle of the campground. Each campsite is on a wood platform that is up off the ground and can hold only a 32ft RV or smaller. A golf cart is available for hosts to share.



Responsibilities

Host 1

- Campground bathhouse keep clean
- Hang reservation tags
- Clean grills/firepits

Host 2

- Make reservations
- Sell firewood, ice and giftshop items
