### PARK DESCRIPTION

Norris Dam State Park sits on more than 4,000 acres located on Norris Reservoir. With more than 800 miles of shoreline, the park offers recreational boating, skiing, and fishing along with over 30 miles of multi-use trails. The park has a fully equipped marina with boat ramp available to the general public. Pontoon boats, kayaks and canoes are available for rent.

### HOSTING DESCRIPTION

#### Campground Description

The park has two campgrounds (East & West) and accommodates one host in each. A dump station is located at each campground. All sites have a table, grill, and fire pit. A bathhouse is centrally located in each campground, open during the in-season. A laundromat is located next to the park office, open seasonally.

**West Campground:** March - November

The West Campground has 50 sites with water and electric hook-up, as well as three paved sites suitable for persons with disabilities. This campground is located atop Andrew's Ridge with views of the Cumberland Mountains, and is in the same section of the park that also has the Park Office, Pool & Recreation Area and the park's modern cabins.

*-The West Campground host site is #50 and is a fairly level site with shade. This site does not have sewer hook ups or Wi-Fi.*

**East Campground:** March - November

The East Campground has 25 sites with water and electric hook-up and 10 primitive sites for tents only, with no water or electric hook-up. This campground is located past the west park entrance and marina and on the other side of Norris Dam. Campsites mainly full-sun and are along a ridge in the historic CCC track, where the park's historical CCC Cabins, threshing mill, grist mill and the W.G. Lenoir Museum are also located.

*- The East Campground host site is on #17. It is a level site, in full sun, and has sewer hook-ups. This site does not have Wi-Fi.*

#### Responsibilities

- Check in campers as needed
- Change/update site markers
- Remove trash at sites
- Clean fire rings and grills
- Spot clean and empty trash as needed in restrooms
- Keep sites clean and leaf blow as needed
- Report any incidents to park rangers as necessary
- Work in the camp store as needed
