PARK DESCRIPTION

Located on the Tims Ford Reservoir, Tims Ford State park sits in the shadows of the Cumberland Plateau in south-central Tennessee. The Tims Ford Lake is considered one of the most picturesque lakes in Tennessee and is regarded as one of the top bass fishing and recreational lakes in the Southeast.

HOSTING DESCRIPTION

Campground Description

Tims Ford State Park has 3 Camping Areas

Main Campground -

Located in the main park on Campground Circle. This campground is wooded and located along the top of a ridge. Most of the sites are a very short walk to the lake and many sites have a view of the lake.

This is an RV campground with 52 sites.

Fairview Campground -

Located 8 miles from the main park on Fairview Campground Rd. and is close to Winchester. This campground has trees but is mostly open. It is a flat campground surrounded by the lake. All sites have views of the lake and most are lakefront. This is an RV campground with 82 sites

Turkey Creek Campground -

Located 9 miles from the main park on Turkey Creek Boat Dock Rd. and is a short drive from Tullahoma. This campground is mostly open. It is a short walk or drive to the lake and a boat ramp. This is a primitive campground with 20 sites.

Host Site Description

Schedule: March - November

Main Campground -

The host site is located beside the camp store on the way into the campground. Trailer/RV may be pulled in or backed into this site. It is equipped with water, sewer, and electric.

Fairview Campground -

The host site is located in the middle of the campground on site #72. This is a back-in site with water, sewer, and electric.

Turkey Creek Campground -

The host site is located outside the campground next to the bath house. This is a back-in site with water, sewer, and electric.
